**Five Questions Our Text Poses**  
**— Five Questions With The Same Answer:**

**Who Can Oppose Us?**

**Romans 8:31(NASB)**

What then shall we say to these things? If God *is* for us, who *is* against us?

**Romans 8:32(NASB)**

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

**Who Can Accuse Us?**

**Romans 8:33(NASB)**

Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies;

**Who Can Condemn Us?**

**Romans 8:34(NASB)**

Who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.

**Who Can Separate Us?**

**Romans 8:35(NASB)**

Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

**Romans 8:38-39(NASB)**

38For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup>nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**What Cannot Separate Us from God:**

1. Death
2. Fear of life
3. Spiritual things
4. Devil
5. Present situation
6. The future

**Romans 8:37(NASB)**
