

## Romans Who's Calling? Romans 10:1-13

### The Way Of Righteousness

**Romans 10:1-4(NASB)** 1Brethren, my heart's desire and my prayer to God for them is for *their* salvation. <sup>2</sup>For I testify about them that they have a zeal for God, but not in accordance with knowledge. <sup>3</sup>For not knowing about God's righteousness and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. <sup>4</sup>For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

### The Way Of Relationship

**Romans 10:5(NASB)** 5For Moses writes that the man who practices the righteousness which is based on law shall live by that righteousness.

**Romans 10:6-7(NASB)** 6But the righteousness based on faith speaks as follows: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down), <sup>7</sup>or 'Who will descend into the abyss?' (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead)."

**Romans 10:8-9(NASB)** 8But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, <sup>9</sup>that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

**Romans 10:10-11(NASB)** 10for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. <sup>11</sup>For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed."

**Romans 10:12-13(NASB)** 12For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same *Lord* is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; <sup>13</sup>for "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved."
